Tuition per student is \$700 for VIQC and FLL. VRC is \$800.

We are committed to supporting underrepresented groups in STEM. To help us achieve this mission, we are offering a tiered tuition structure in order to ensure access for all. The CCR semester program tuition cost is dependent on household income. Each TIER offers a scholarship based on household income.
